

Regulations on Credit Transfer

For Bachelor of Arts Program in Service Innovation (International Program) College of Innovation Thammasat University

By and with the authority according to the Thammasat University Regulation on Undergraduate Degrees B.E. 2540 (with a revision until B.E. 2555), item 15 and B.E. 2561 Part 7, the College of Innovation hereby authorized the College Executive Committees to review and approve of granting credit transfer under the following conditions.

- 1. Students ID. 57 60 who are eligible for credit transfer must be qualified according to the Thammasat University Regulation on Undergraduate Degrees B.E. 2540 (with a revision until B.E. 2555), item 15.1.
- 2. Students ID. 61 and onward who are eligible for credit transfer must be qualified according to the Thammasat University Regulation on Undergraduate Degrees B.E. 261 item 31.
 - 3. No transfer credits can be granted if the student has been dismissed from an institution.
 - 4. Total number of transfer credits cannot exceed 30.
- 5. For the first-year students, <u>only</u> general education courses can be transferred. To expedite the processing of the transferring of credits, students must submit a request to the College of Innovation four weeks prior to the period of enrollment and registration and submit the following documents.
- 5.1 An official transcript from previous institution indicating grading results of courses to be credit transferred which has at least a GPA of 2.00 out of 4.00 scale.
 - 5.2 An official resignation letter from previous institution.
- 6. The second-year students or upper-year students, who studied under a joint academic program, academic exchange program, or self-scholarship to take courses at other universities or institutions under the MOU of Thammasat University, are eligible for credit transfer according to the Thammasat University Regulation.
- 7. Eligible courses for credit transfer must be with an earned grade of "C" or P (Passed) or S (Satisfaction) or its equivalence.
- 8. Course exemption will be recorded according to the Thammasat University Regulation on Undergraduate Degrees B.E. 2540 (with a revision until B.E. 2555) and B.E. 2561 item 33.
- 9. In cases where it does not follow the above conditions, the College Executive Committee is authorized to make a decision.

These regulations shall take effect from 15 June 2018 onward.
